The Maritime Radio Course

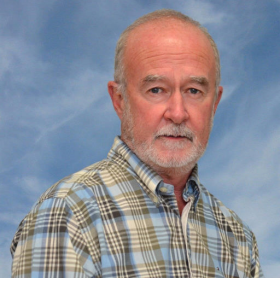
