












Important Notice to all Members

Important Membership Meeting:

Please note that we will be holding a special membership meeting in **June** to discuss the transitioning of the Vernon Yacht Club Society to the New Societies Act.

For those who are new members or those who need a refresher, the new Societies Act requires that every pre-existing Society "transition" to the new Act.

"Transitioning" really is quite simple and requires a society to re-file, in electronic format, its current constitution and bylaws with the Corporate Registry. If our Society wishes to make changes to our bylaws now is the time as there are no fees charged to file the changes.

The Executive Committee is working hard on reviewing our bylaws with legal advice and will be providing their recommendations to this special meeting in June, including any amendments to bylaws and the transitioning as a member-funded society.




