If you fail to do this, the Club can be billed up to \$150. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.



it to perfection and carved it to go with the delicious buffet dinner, thank you!






And let's not forget about the Wack Duck Game! The goal: to hit the rubber duck with a golf club into a dinghy.
