

**2019 VYC OKANAGAN REGATTA
WHISKEY ISLAND RACE

Please note that these instructions are for the Whisky (Grant) Island race only – separate instructions exist for the Saturday and Sunday racing.

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017-2021 Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the Canadian national authority CYA will apply
- 1.3 The Rules of PHRF of BC will apply
- 1.4 Yachts shall display their official sail number on both sides of their mainsail

2. Schedule of Races

- 2.1 Friday May 31, 2019 - 14:25 Warning Flag for all participants.

3. Scoring

- 3.1 All boats will be scored using PHRF of BC. There will be only and awards will be presented to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd finishes based on the corrected times. Awards to be presented Sunday June 2, 2019 after 14:30.

4. The Course

- 4.1 The committee boat will set up a start line in the vicinity of Whisky Island. Finish line will be set in front of the Vernon Yacht Club (keep flashing light at Cameron Point to Starboard).

Note: In the case of very light winds the race may be finished at Cameron Point instead of at the yacht Club in which case the finish will be between the Flashing light on

Cameron Point and the RC flag on the Committee Boat.

4.2 To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will move the original mark (or finishing line) to a new position.

5. The Start

5.1 Races will be started by using rule 26 with the warning signal given 5 Minutes before the starting signal:

Signal	Flag	Sound	Time to Start
Warning Signal	Class Flag Up	1 sound	5 minutes
Preparatory Signal	Blue Flag Up	1 sound	4 minutes
One minute signal	Blue Flag down	1 sound	1 minute
Start Signal	Class Flag down	1 sound	0 minute

5.2 The starting line will be between the RC flag on the committee boat and Mark X.

6. Marks

6.1 The starting and finishing lines will be between the Committee Boat and positioned start/finish mark.

Note: In the case of very light winds the race may be finished at Cameron Point instead of at the yacht Club in which case the finish will be between the Flashing light on Cameron Point and the RC flag on the Committee Boat.

7. Time limits

7.1 Time limit for all boats will be 4 hrs 30 min.

7.2 Boats failing to finish within 90 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not finish. This changes rules 35 and A4.

8. Protests and Requests for Redress

8.1 Protest forms are available at the race office. Protests shall be delivered there within the protest time limit._
