#### About Vernon Yacht Club's regatta:

70 years ago, the Vernon Yacht Club was started by a group of sailors and every year since they invite sailors from clubs down the lake to participate in a sailing regatta. In 2001, sailor and VYC member Dave Ellis turned the annual VYC regatta into the Okanagan Charity Regatta, which ran for 10 years under several volunteer chairpersons and many volunteers. During those years the charity regatta raised a few hundred thousand dollars for charity. Except for the two years during the pandemic, the sailing regatta is an annual VYC event and in 2022 we had a great turnout with more than 150 participants!

#### Why bring back the Okanagan Charity Regatta:

Over the past three years, BC has seen a global pandemic, devastating fires and floods and an increase in communities' needs for more food in food banks, in disaster relief areas and in hard-to-reach remote regions. In addition to this, all corners of our communities are affected by higher living costs and our daily news highlights families and individuals struggling to feed themselves.

United Way and Community Foundations quickly stepped in to fill many essential needs, developing 18 food hubs across BC, increasing access to food, supporting food security organizations and bringing support to remote areas. Starting in 2023, the Okanagan Charity Regatta is once again sailing for donations and sponsorships in support of United Way BC and Community Foundation North Okanagan for the food security programs they support in our local regions. The Vernon Yacht Club is a non-profit and events are run by hundreds of volunteers each year and a handful of fabulous staff.

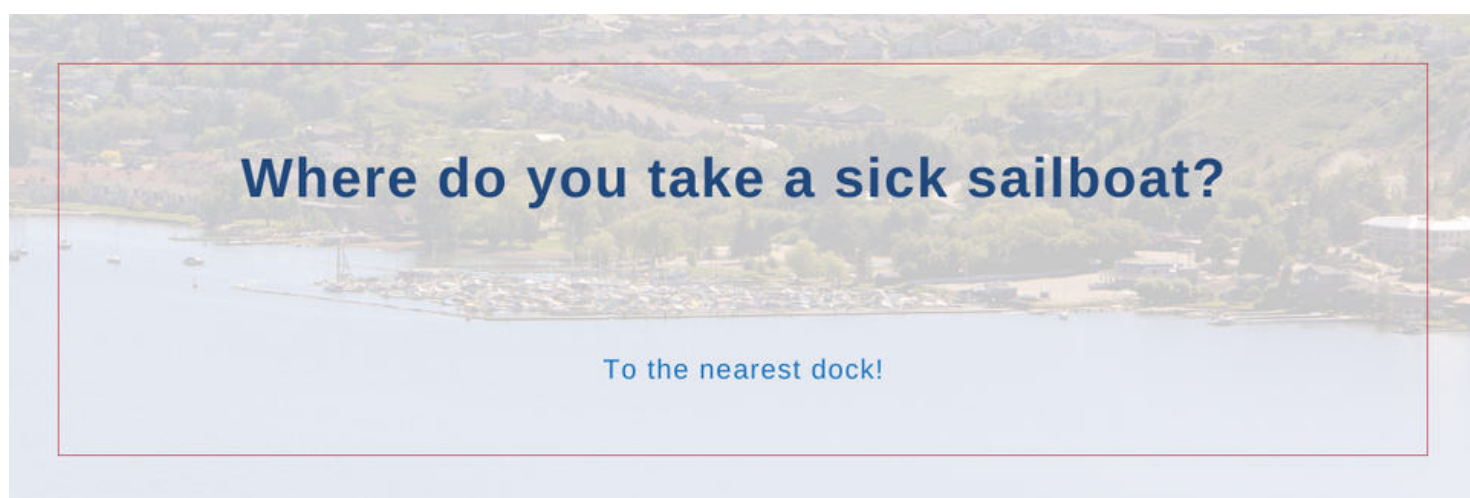

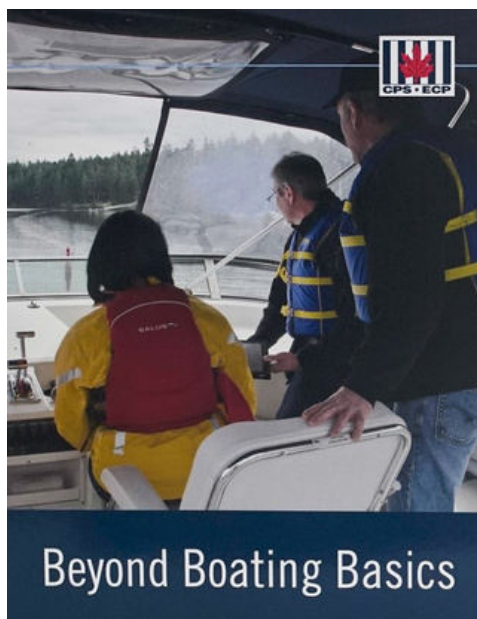

Boating 1 – Pleasure Craft Operator Card (PCOC)



#### Details

e-learning with weekly webinar and assigned local tutor

The PCOC makes sure you have immediate navigation and safety skills, but it's just the beginning of what you should know when you get on a boat. In the second of our Boating Series, you are introduced to the art and science of marine navigation, anchoring, ropes, lines and knots – not to mention what to expect when the boat is moving under power. The course also has a number of optional topics that will be taught depending on your interest. These include towing, trailering, and a check list for layup and launch.

The Maritime Radio course teaches emergency radio procedures and everyday operating techniques. Learn all about the uses of marine radios, choice of frequencies, operation, phonetic alphabet, procedural words and phrases, as well as Digital Selective Calling and the Global Maritime Distress and Safety System, (DSC/GMDSS).

All mariners, including recreational boaters, will want to take advantage of the many features and capabilities of this innovative form “automatic” radio. Secure your lifeline. Be sure that you and your family take the Maritime Radio course. This complete package will prepare you for the Restricted Operator Certificate (Maritime) with DSC Endorsement exam which is included as part of this courses. To operate a maritime radio, you require the certificate. It's the law!



We have scheduled an in-person, classroom VHF Radio course for Tuesday evening (March 21) plus a full day Saturday (March 25) at the Vernon Yacht Club.
