POLICY STATEMENT
<p>All existing dock boxes are grandfathered in place up to the point they need to be replaced or relocated at which time a new dock box application will need to be submitted.</p> <p>Due to the variation in size and design of our docks and fingers, not all locations in the Marina will accommodate a dock box. Each request will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.</p> <p>A dock box application must be submitted and approved before a dock box can be installed. Applications must be submitted in writing and include all of the following information - slip # - description of box selected from the approved box list - detailed drawing of the location the box will be installed -name of member - size and style of boat - moorage method i.e. bow in, stern in.</p> <p>Any member may in writing appeal the decision made to the executive for review.</p> <p>All dock box applications are approved or declined at the sole discretion of the Rear Commodore.</p> <p>Dock boxes must be maintained, Dock boxes which are unsuitably maintained shall be immediately removed by the member owning the box or will be removed by VYC at owner's expense. Duct tape, bungee cord or tie downs are not an appropriate repair. If repairs are not done within 10 days of written notes the box will be removed by VYC staff.</p> <p>Repaired boxes must be inspected and approved by the Fleet Captain or Rear Commodore before they may be reinstalled.</p> <p>All dock boxes will be made of weather resistant, maintenance free materials (fiberglass, or polypropylene) - as per the approved supply list.</p> <p>Dock boxes will be mounted in such a manner to be secure but in no way interfere with member travel on the main walkway or interfere with access to any finger, and in a manner that allows for easy removal.</p> <p>Dock boxes must not interfere with access or egress to or from any member's boat.</p> <p>Members MUST receive written permission before the installation of any dock box - boxes installed without written permission will be removed by VYC staff.</p>

Dock boxes are for the storage of non flammable goods only. Violation will result in removal of the dock box and possible suspension of moorage (ie: no propane tank, gas container).

The executive reserves the right to remove any box from the VYC docks even if it has been previously approved if the dock box is deemed to be inappropriate in any way.

Not all applications can be approved as we must maintain a safe and functional dock at all times.
